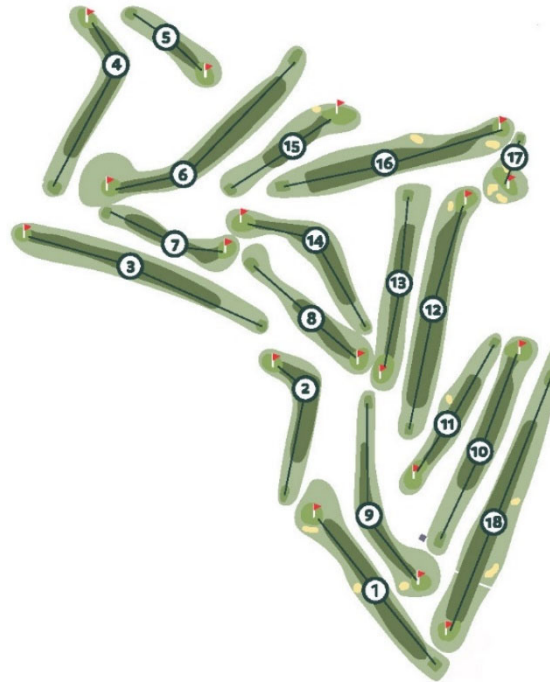
Meet local women with a common interest in golf and improve your game!

Q. How well do I have to play to join the League?

A. Members have a wide range of abilities. Our handicaps range from the teens to the 40s. Ideally, you should score under 130 for 18 holes and be accustomed to playing at an acceptable pace-of-play.

Q. What if I don't have a handicap?

A. Submission of three scores is all it takes to establish a handicap -- 9-hole scores do count.

Each player in our League pays a slope fee to the Wisconsin State Golf Association (WSGA) as part of their dues. Members submit ALL scores, from any course, to the WSGA either online or via an app. Your handicap index is adjusted the day after each round is posted.

Q. Do I have to commit to golfing every Sunday during the Summer?

A. Nope! A few weeks before the start of a new month, we distribute a sign-up sheet. You sign up for the weeks you can make it! You must participate in five weekly events and at least one monthly event to qualify for prize money, however. The monthly events typically stretch over 3 out of the 4 Sundays, so there is always a make-up week. Can't golf a few Sundays out of the month? That's fine. Golf when you can, you just won't be participating in the monthly event.

Q. What if I don't know all the rules?

A. We don't expect you to know all the rules. Most members have a good general knowledge of golf rules and are happy to help if you have a question or need clarification. We do have a Tournament Chairperson as well as a Rules Chairperson to consult should the need arise.

Q. Do I have to play against better players?

A. The idea of the League is to improve your game and meet new women who also enjoy golfing. You

might play in matches with players of different abilities. Most matches are handicapped, however, to equalize the competition. Prizes and awards are based on your flight. Flights consist of players with comparable skill levels.

Q. What types of competitions do we play in?

A. We have month-long events like Low Net and Nassau Matches, weekly events like Most 2 Putts, Most Drives in the Fairway and Most of the Same Score per Hole. In August, everyone competes in our League Championship which spans the entire month. There is a Champion within each flight.

Q. What happens to the League membership dues?

A. Most of our membership dues are redistributed to the members as prize money at the Fall Banquet. Some of the funds are used to defray the cost of events such as the Spring Luncheon or Opening Day. Players qualify for prizes once they have a handicap and have participated in five weekly events and at least one monthly event. That also qualifies them for the League championship.
